The Ray S. Jones Scholarship is awarded annually and is available to students that meet the following criteria:

- Must be a permanent resident of Camden or Pasquotank County
- Must attend Wake Forest University, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill or North Carolina State University as a full-time student
- Must exhibit financial need
- May be renewed if adequate progress is being made in a degree program with a minimum of a 2.0 GPA

Applicants who have been enrolled in a college or university must obtain and submit an official transcript (with the institution's official seal). Applicants who have no college or university experience, must obtain an official high school transcript. Transcripts will not be accepted if submitted separately from the application.
